

WAISAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Smoking, drinking alcohol, drug use, and/ or possession, or extreme inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated at any time**

Consequences:

Any infraction will result in the student being sent home at the student's expense and suspension from all WAILAS activities for 90 days after the host school administrator made the decision. Cost incurred in addition to these costs for the students being sent home will be the responsibility of the student. The home school may levy additional financial penalties. It will be the responsibility of the student's home school to impose further appropriate disciplinary action

- 2. Transportation will be provided only by the host school or parents of the host schools or drivers employed by the parents. Exception, if any, will be communicated to visiting school by the host school in advance of the event.**

Consequences:

Suspension from the next game/ event. The consequences of violation of any of these items will be suspension from all the activities for 24 hours. If the violation occurs on the last day of the event, the students will be suspended from all the activities on the last day. It will be the responsibility of the student's home school to impose further appropriate disciplinary action.

- 3. Students must remain under the supervision of host families when not participating in scheduled activities or when not under the direct supervision of their coach/ staff. Time allocated for Study Nights must be adhered to in the host's home.**

Consequences:

Suspension from the next game/ event. The consequences of violation of any of these items will be suspension for 24 hours. If the violation occurs on the last day of the event, the students will be suspended from all the activities on the last day. It will be the responsibility of the student's home school to impose further appropriate disciplinary action.

- 4. Curfew: Each student must be in the host family's home by 9:00 pm for middle/ high school events and 10:00 pm for high school events, at the latest, or at an alternative time as designated by the Administrator in Charge at the host school.**

Consequences:

Suspension from the next game/ event. The consequences of violation of any of these items will be suspension for 24 hours. If the violation occurs on the last day of the event, the students will be suspended from all the activities on the last day. It will be the responsibility of the student's home school to impose further appropriate disciplinary action.

Responsibility for enforcing this code of conduct rests with the visiting school staff designated and authorized by the visiting school superintendent or principal.

If the visiting school fails to enforce the code of conduct the Host school superintendent and/ or principal may initiate the enforcement of the code by applying the consequences outlined above.

General:

- A. If any violation of the above occurs, the Host Administrator will communicate the details of the violation, in writing, to the Guest Student's Chief Administrator.
- B. The Administrator encourages students to seek advance assignments from their teachers prior to departure. The host school will set aside time and locations for students to study.
- C. Guest students and supervisors will receive a list of details for that activity. Students are expected to follow the rules and must attend the scheduled activities as listed on the Activity Program.
- D. Students may not use any medications unless prescribed and/ or administered by a licensed physician or host school medical personnel or cleared and recorded by the Activity Director.
- E. Students and parents may not contact the host school or host school family to change assigned housing. Housing is the sole responsibility of the host school.
- F. Visiting schools will inform athletes and delegates of the following:
WAISAL welcomes parental attendance at its events. When attending WAISAL events parents should be aware that the responsibility for their children is the traveling coaches/ staff and, ultimately, the host school's. Under no circumstances therefore, should parents take their children away from WAISAL activities unless prior approval has been gained from the team coach/staff and the host school administrator.
